The Veterans' Department is under the direction of Chapter 115 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. We direct the Veterans Benefit Program, which is a joint program with the Commonwealth and the Town to deliver veteran benefits for qualified veterans and their dependents. Our office also aids, assists and advises veterans and their dependents with questions and applications concerning federal benefits.

The Veterans Medical Van visits the Town of Clinton on the second Tuesday of each month from 10:00 A.M. until 3:00 P.M. at the American Legion, 239 Chestnut Street, Clinton. Any veteran that needs medical services should bring a copy of their discharge or DD214 to register for health care and prescription drug services.
