  - Jonathan spoke with Joe. While Jonathan not in attendance, Joe recapped their discussion as to what labor and other costs would be. Jonathan's template is a good as far as what the cost would be seasonal and how to work with getting the numbers into the template.
  - Joe we lose some aspects of not joining a program and relying on volunteers or other staff members taking on the responsibility of the surveillance
  - Don agrees that not using trained professionals for surveillance, we may not be getting the full effect of what we are looking for
  - Scott We could still rely on volunteers to help with the efforts
  - Jan citizen who joined the meeting speaks to the matter. She has a background on working with children with special needs. She feels that pesticides cause problems in human life. She feels control would be best rather than spraying.
- Companies offering surveillance services (Scott)
  - Spoke with +++. For various reasons they are not going forward with program. State is going forward with a program similar to CMMCP. Suggested that we get in touch with someone at UMass. Scott spoke with Mr. Stephen Rich, mentioned a fair amount of state politics, there are also surveillance for ticks (Hamden and Hampshire county). He also stated that the state is looking to keep control of surveillance programs and may not recognize results of testing.
  - Another company from last meeting Polaris integrated pest management Scott did not have a chance to speak with them. But in review of their website, it's focus is on orchards.
  - Don The state is focused on spraying in their new proposal. Don does not feel we should rely on what the state is rolling out.
